PASTOR'S THOUGHT: I Peter 1:3 – "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead."

Many Christians often find themselves besieged with doubt and uncertainty regarding their salvation. Yet no one who has truly entered God's family should ever fear leaving it – it is impossible. We are not saved by our own work, but by grace alone. If our salvation depended on us we could surely risk losing it, but since salvation is all of God, the keeping of those who come to Him is also completely His responsibility.
